

VSL Update on Corona Virus - At a Glance

Latest Update: 17 March 2020

- The last session for Centre Language classes for Term 1 is on Saturday 21 March (for mid-week classes check with the relevant Centre Supervisor).
- This will be followed by the standard three-week Term 1 holidays with classes resuming on **Saturday 18 April** (with equivalent dates for mid-week classes).
- Students/parents/teachers should be aware that the Government might extend the Term 1 holidays beyond Monday 13 April.
- The Distance Education programs (classes) of the Victorian School of Languages will continue as normal.
- Students who attend schools that have closed because of cases of corona virus (or suspected cases) **cannot** attend VSL face-to-face centre classes. At the moment the following students from the schools below are excluded from our face-to-face classes:
 - Carey Baptist Grammar
 - Beth Rivkhar Girls College
 - St Kevin's College (Toorak)
 - Lowther Hall Anglican Grammar (Essendon)
 - Toorak Primary School
- This list may be incomplete as schools do not inform us of their decisions. The simple process is that if a school is closed because of a Corona Virus case then students **must NOT attend VSL classes at Centres** until the schools reopen.
- The VSL State-wide Staff Conference on 8 August will not go ahead unless circumstances change.
- EAL teachers' visits to schools are temporarily suspended until further notice.
