

Latest update: 26 March 2020

- The Term 1 Centre classes have finished.
- Similarly, all Distance Education teaching programs (classes for Term 1 have also finished. Distance Education students will be receiving their distance Workbooks by the first week of the holidays.
- Due to the COVID-19 all **new** online student enrolments are suspended until further notice – this is for both Centre classes and Distance Education classes.
- After the Term 1 holidays finish, the Centre Classes are due to resume on Saturday 18 April. However, the current indication is that this is unlikely to happen and that all school-aged students will be working from home in Term 2. We will place any new government changes on this website.
- Students in centre classes **must** be available to be in contact with their Language teacher on the same dates and times as for when they physically attend the Centres. For **Term 2** the dates are as follows: (Saturdays): 18 April, 2 May, 9 May, 16 May, 23 May, 30 May, 13 June, 20 June, (27 June is VCE only). There are equivalent dates for mid-week classes. In the event that students are working from home, parents can assist their child/children by providing:
  - an appropriate learning environment between 9.00am and 12.15pm where the students will not be interrupted;
  - a digital device (ipad, laptop) with access to email and internet; and
  - assistance with learning tasks and other support as required.
- The Distance Education Courses (classes) will resume on Wednesday 15 April and continue from where they left off in Term 1.
- Students/parents/teachers should be aware that the Government might extend the Term 1 holidays beyond Tuesday 14 April.
- All associated school gatherings will, of course, not go ahead (concerts, seminars, staff conferences, etc).

Let us hope that this extraordinary emergency and associated suffering finishes as soon as possible and that we go back to having a normal life.
